OBITUARY REFERENCE

Mr. Speaker: I have to inform the House of the sad demise of Pandit Govind Malaviya who passed away at 4 A.M. today at New Delhi at the age of 59.

Pandit Malaviya was a sitting member of this House from the Sultanpur constituency of Uttar Pradesh. He was also a member of the former Central Legislative Assembly during the years 1945—47; of the Constituent Assembly of India during the years 1946—50 and of the Provisional Parliament during the years 1950—52. All members who have had the opportunity of sitting along with him will kindly recollect that he was a bold

fighter and a good speaker. He was contributing much to the debates of Parliament. He was also the Vice-Chancellor of the Banaras Hindu University from 1948 to 1952 and used to take keen interest in educational and other matters.

We deeply mourn the loss of this friend, I am sure the House will join me in conveying our condolences to the bereaved family.

May I request the House to stand in silence for a short while to express its sorrow?
