- (b) the number of procurement centres opened during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open additional procurement centres during the ensuing season in various States particularly Karnataka; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

- (b): The number of procurement centres opened during the last three years and the current year, State-wise is given in Annexure IV and V.
- (c) & (d): The number of procurement centres to be opened in each State (including in Karnataka) will be decided by FCI, in consultation with the respective State Governments before the commencement of the ensuing Kharif Marketing Season 2007-08 which is due to commence on 1st October, 2007.
