(a)&(b) The Union Finance Minister in his Budget Speech for 2007-08 had announced a scheme at a cost of Rs. 1800 crores for ground water recharge through dugwells in Over- Exploited and Critical blocks in Hard Rock areas of 7 identified States namely, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. The scheme envisages 100% subsidy to small and marginal farmers and 50% subsidy to other farmers.
