(a) & (b): India's coastal waters and coastal areas are guarded by the Indian Coast Guard in coordination with the State Police and the Indian Navy. Surveillance and maritime patrolling along he coast are regularly done by the Indian Navy and the Indian Coast Guard. The measures that have been taken and planned to ensure the security of areas and establishments located on the coasts include regular aerial surveillance, establishment of coastal police stations in the littoral States, vessel monitoring system, etc.
