(a) to (c) The recommendations of Parthasarathy Committee are under examination of the Government. After having wide ranging consultations, a comprehensive set of guidelines titled "Common Guidelines for Watershed Management 2007" has been drafted. It has been proposed to integrate and consolidate the schemes of Integrated Wastelands Development Programme (IWDP), Drought Prone Area Programme (DPAP), and Desert Development Programme (DDP) within the Ministry of Rural Development for integrated planning and sustainable outcomes during the 11th Five year Plan.
