Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Union Government had introduced National Pulses Development Project (NPDP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether since the introduction of the said project, the production of the said project, the production rate of pulses has increased/decreased;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to boost production of pulses in the country?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTI LAL BHURIA)

(a)to(e): National Pulses Development Project (NPDP) was implemented in the country from 1990-91 to 2003-04. However, NPDP was merged into a Centrally Sponsored Integrated Scheme of Oilseeds, Pulses, Oilpalm & Maize (ISOPOM) which is in operation in 14 major pulses producing states with effect from 1st April, 2004. The production of pulses in the year (1989-90) prior to the inception of NPDP was 12.86 million tonnes which has increased to 14.23 million tonnes in the year 2006-07 (IV Advance Estimates). The productivity of pulses has also increased from 549 kg/ha to 594 kg/ha during the same period.

Further, in pursuance of the resolution adopted in the 53rd Meeting of National Development Council, it is proposed to launch 'National Food Security Mission' comprising rice, wheat and pulses during XI Plan to enhance the production and productivity of these crops and make the country self-sufficient in food grains.
