## Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the three armed services are planning to come out with the first ever joint services doctrine;
- (b) the details thereof;
- (c) whether it has been felt by the Navy that there is much happening at sea; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) Based on the study of military history, principles of war, combat leadership and application of military power in the Indian scenario, a Joint armed services doctrine broadly covering strategic military aspects is being formulated by the Headquarters of Integrated Defence Staff (HQ IDS), in consultation with the three Services, with a view to synergize the capabilities of the three Services into an effective force.
- (c) The Government monitors and analyses all developments at sea on a continuous basis and takes appropriate measures considered necessary to safeguard our national interest.
- (d) It would not be in the national interest to divulge details in this regard.
