- (a) whether the Karnataka Government has submitted proposals for funds in view of the changes made in the guidelines of Total Sanitation Campaign;
- (b) if so, whether the funds for this proposal have been released;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time, by which the amount is likely to be released ?

(a) to (d) proposals for all the 27 districts of Karnataka have been received and approved in view of the changes made in the guidelines of Total Sanitation Campaign. Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) is demand driven programme and as such funds are released as per the demand raised by the respective State and within the criteria laid down. In the year 2007-08, Rs.551.23 lakh has been released to Karnataka till date, as per their demand.
