Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R.VELU)

- (a) & (b): Unreserved Ticketing System(UTS) and Internet Ticketing System(ITS) have been introduced.
- (c): UTS has been introduced in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Delhi, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Uttranchal and West Bengal States.

ITS has been introduced in all States of the country.

(d): A large number of passengers have benefited from the system.
