(a) & (b) : The Planning Commission has received proposals from various State Governments to amend the existing Gadgil-Mukherjee Formula for allocating Normal Central Assistance to State Plans. There is wide divergence in the views amongst the States in this regard. This issue was considered in a meeting of the Full Planning Commission held on 27th and 29th June, 2001. Since revision in the Formula requires the approval of National Development Council (NDC), it was decided that given the difference of opinion among the State Governments and the sensitivity of this issue, it was necessary to discuss this further and evolve a consensus before alternatives are considered by the NDC.
