(a) to (e): Government have constituted an 11 Member Committee on Infrastructure under the Chairmanship of Prime Minister with the objectives of initiating policies to ensure creation of world class infrastructure facilities; developing structures that maximize the role of Public Private Partnerships; and monitoring of key infrastructure projects. The Committee will deal with railways, roads, ports, telecommunications, petroleum and power sectors. To begin with, sector-wise policy initiatives and action plans are being prepared by the Planning Commission in consultation with the concerned Ministries/Departments.
