## Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have announced a two pronged strategy to complete 26 pending irrigation projects on a fast track basis to benefit 17.6 lakhs acres;
- (b) if so, whether any action plan has been worked out in this regard; and
- (c) if so, by when it is likely to be implemented and completed?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV) (a) to (c) The Central Government has not announced a two pronged strategy to complete 26 pending irrigation projects on a fast track basis to benefit 17.6 lakh acre. However, Government of Andhra Pradesh has announced a strategy to complete 26 projects to benefit 17.6 lakh acre on fast track in a phased manner. As per the action plan of the State Government 8 projects are programmed to be completed in two years and 18 projects in 5 years.
