MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE)

(a) & (b): Indian Air Force is in the process of phasing out the MiG-21, MiG- 23 and MiG-25 fighter aircraft depending upon the calendar life/total technical life of the aircraft. These aircraft will be phased out from the service between the years 2006 to 2017.

(c) No, Sir. Since an aircraft is deemed not to be airworthy at the end of its life, it is disposed off as per the laid down procedure.
