- (a) & (b): Food and agro-based processing units of small and medium size with investment in plant and machinery up to Rs 5 crore is included! under priority sector lending.
- (e) & (d): No, Sir. NABARD has identified Agro Processing, including Food Processing as a thrust area. It extends refinance support to Banks for then lending to Food Processing Industries.
- (e) & (f): No, Sir.
- (g): The percentage of contribution in priority sector lending was 44.14, 47.27 & 43.63 per cent during 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05, respectively by the private banks.
