(c) whether some State Governments have also shown interest in setting up of CNG stations along National Highways ; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Union Government thereto?

(a) & (b): No, Sir. However, it is proposed to progressively introduce CNG in a greater number of cities, with the expansion of the pipeline infrastructure and the increased availability of natural gas.
