(a), (b) & (c): Good quality wheat and rice conforming to the specifications laid down by the Government and the PFA norms are issued to the States and Union Territories for distribution to the families living below poverty line under the Targeted Public Distribution System. No complaint has been received from any State Government regarding poor quality of foodgrains. However, a complaint received from President, Shahide Azam Balidan Divas Sanyojan Samiti, Meerut and Secretary, Desh Bhakt Society, Meerut regarding distribution of damaged wheat to below poverty line families in district Meerut, UP have been forwarded to the State Government for investigation and for further appropriate action.
