Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has recommended an increase in the National Floor Level Minimum Wages;

(b) if so, the details of minimum wages recommended by the Union Government;

(c) the instructions issued to States in this regard; and

(d) the steps taken by the Union Government to implement the increased minimum wages?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI OSCAR FERNANDES)

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): The National Floor Level Minimum Wage has been revised from Rs. 66/- to Rs. 80/- per day with effect from 01.09.2007.

(c) & (d): The revision of National Floor Level Minimum Wages by the Government is a non-statutory measure. Thus the State/UT Governments have been requested to revise the minimum wages upwards so as to ensure that in none of the scheduled employments; the minimum wages are less than the national floor level minimum wage of Rs. 80/- per day.
