MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGUPATHY)

(a): Till now, no party other than the Government of India Representative for Naga Peace Talks has participated in the talks with NSCN(I/M) leaders.

(b) & (c): Thirty rounds of discussions have already taken place between the Government of India's Representative for Naga Peace Talks and NSCN (I/M) leaders. The issues are complex. It will not be desirable to disclose further details in public interest.
