(a) No Sir. At present, it is difficult to isolate the impacts of global warming at specific locations because a multitude of complex physical factors are responsible for local level changes

(b) No Sir. The rains and floods that have occurred are within the natural rainfall variations. These observed events can not be exclusively attributed to climate change.
