(a) to (c): Draft National Pharmaceutical Policy was considered by the Cabinet at its meeting held on 11.1.2007. The Cabinet has referred the Policy to Group of Ministers (GOM). The First meeting of the GOM was held on 10.4.2007 and the Second meeting was held on 12-9-2007. No time frame has been set for finalizing the National Pharmaceuticals Policy. Since no final decision has been taken on the draft National Pharmaceuticals Policy, 2006, it would not be possible, at present, to assess/ascertain the impact of price control on drugs.
