STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a), (b) & (c) OF LOK mSABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.62 FOR 20.11.2007 ASKED BY SHRI RAMPAL SINGH AND BADIGA RAMAKRISHNA REGARDING ACHIEVEMENT OF TARGETS UNDER SARVA SHIKSHA ABHIYAN

(a) to (c): Some of the States whose performance under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is lagging behind are Bihar and Manipur in civil works for school infrastructure due to difficulties in availability of land and technical manpower respectively; and West Bengal and Bihar in teacher recruitment due to delays on account of court cases. To ensure timely implementation a rigorous system of monitoring of the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan has been put in place.
