(a) to (e) The National Knowledge Commission, in its report on Medical Education has inter-alia recommended for making medical education nationally sensitive and globally competitive, creation of an independent regulatory body to regulate and maintain the standard of medical education in the country, conversion of Medical Council of India, Nursing Council of India and Rehabilitation Council of India into professional association with the power to conduct nationwide examinations, regulation of admission and fee structure in private medical colleges, revamping of continuing Medical Education (CME) and re-registration of doctors every five years based on evaluation of credit earned through CME, reservation of certain percentage of Post Graduate seats for doctors serving in rural areas, removal of regional disparity in the availability of medical colleges etc. The report of National Knowledge Commission on Medical Education is under examination.
