- (a) the details of National Level Health and Family Welfare Programmes and Projects that are under implementation in the State of Andhra Pradesh at present;
- (b) if the amount allocated for the implementation of the schemes; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (c): The Government of India has launched the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) which includes Reproductive and Child Health (RCH-II) Program and various disease control programmes and related schemes like training, IEC etc. A detailed list including allocation of funds and schemes is placed at Annexure.

The Andhra Pradesh Health Sector Reforms Programme (AP HSRP) developed by DFID and Government of AP, is being implemented by the Department of Health, Medical and Family Affairs of the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The first tranche of £9.5 million has been released to the State for the activities of 2007-08.

The States are frequently monitored at planning and implementation stage for completion of planned activities.
