## Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is contemplating to encourage private participation in water harvesting;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and

(c) the number of proposals received by the Government from the State Governments alongwith action taken thereon?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV)

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. A Centrally Sponsored Scheme on "Artificial Recharge to Ground Water and Rain Water Harvesting" for implementation with active involvement of the beneficiaries including Local Bodies/Panchayats/Water User Association/Communities/Non Government Organisations/Voluntary Organisations has been conceived.

(c) The proposals for increasing the activities in water conservation from the State Governments would depend upon the approval of the proposed Centrally Sponsored Scheme.
