(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Rajiv Sagar (Bawanthadi) Irrigation project is an inter-State Irrigation project between Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra. The project has been given investment clearance by the Planning Commission in 1999 with an estimated cost of Rs.161.57 crore (1988-89 price level). The culturable command area of the project is 36,152 hectare. The scheduled completion of the project is by the end of Tenth Five Year Plan.
