(a) to (c) A Sub-Committee was constituted as per decision of the Artificial Recharge of Ground Water Advisory Council to suggest a policy for water for Industries having the framework for regulation as well as incentives for economic use for large users of ground water. Workshops have been held to discuss various recommendations of the Sub-Committee.
