(a) & (b) Water being a State subject, it is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Governments to formulate plans for augmenting water resources. The Central Ground Water Board (CGWB), under the Ministry of Water Resources, has also conceived a Centrally Sponsored Scheme at an estimated cost of Rs. 175 crores for Artificial Recharge to Groundwater and Rainwater Harvesting during the remaining part of the X Five Year Plan. This scheme includes the State of Orissa also with thrust on drought prone areas.
