- (a) whether there has been a decline in the total outlay meant for research and patient care in the AllMS;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether AIIMS has sought an increase in its budgetary allocation;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (e) the steps taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government to improve the services being provided to the people and to provide adequate funds to the institute for its research activities?

- (a) to (b): The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AllMS) received consolidated Grant-in-Aids every year under Plan and Non-Plan from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for patient care services, teaching & research activities.
- (c) to (e): The AllMS has projected an overall amount of Rs.692.75 crores under Plan & Non-Plan activities in Budget Estimates (BE) 2008-09. Towards this projection, the Institute has been provided an overall amount of Rs.452.00 crores under Plan & Non-Plan activities in BE 2008-09. However, the standards of patient care services including teaching and research activities will be maintained.
