FOOT OVERBRIDGE AT MAU STATION

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether foot overbridge has been constructed only over two platforms out of four at Mau Station;
- (b) if so, whether the Railways propose to construct foot overbridge over the rest of the platforms; and
- (c) if so, the time by which these are likely to be constructed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS(SHRIR. VELU)

(a): Mau railway station has a main platform (Platform No.1) and an island platform. The island platform accommodates Platform nos. 2 & 3 on one face and Platform no. 4 on other face. A foot over bridge connects the main platform and island platforms and thus is serving all the four platforms already existing.
