(a) to (c): Presently there are 64 branches of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in the country. The State-wise branch position is given in the Annexure.

Further, SIDBI has identified 10 more centres for opening branch offices during the next six to seven months. This includes one branch at Hubli, Kamataka.
