Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Gujarat has submitted a proposal for release of 427.13 hectare of forest land coming under the submergence and environment clearance from the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the present status of the proposal; and
- (c) the time by which final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?

(a), (b) & (c) The Government of Gujarat had submitted a proposal for diversion of 427.13 hectare of forest land for Sidumbar Reservoir Irrigation Project in Valsad district of Gujrat for which in-principle (stage-I) approval was accorded by the Central Government on 20.08.2004 with certain mandatory conditions. The Final (stage-II) Approval is accorded only after the receipt of the compliance report form the Government of Gujrat, which is still awaited. However, in cases where compliance of conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval is awaited for more than 5 (five) years from the State Governments, the in-principle approvals are revoked.
