(a) the number of post offices/sub-post offices opened during the last three years, State-wise;

(b) whether the Government has any proposal to open new post offices in the country during 2008-09;

(c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(d) whether the courier services have affected the income of post offices in the country;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to reconcile the losses, if any, as a result of the courier services?

Answer

(a) During the last 3 years, 2 new Extra Departmental Branch Post Offices (EDBOs) and 14 Departmental Sub Post Offices (DSOs) were opened in different Circles. State/Circle wise details are given in the Annexure.

(b) & (c) It is proposed to open 500 new Extra Departmental Branch Post Offices (EDBOs) and 375 new Departmental Sub Post Offices (DSOs) during the year 2008-09. State-wise details for opening of the above Post Offices have not been firmed up as yet.

(d) to (f) In order to meet the market challenges from competition, the Department has introduced a number of business products like Speed Post, Express Parcel Post, Logistics Post, Business Post etc. The revenue from Speed Post etc. is consistently increasing in the past five years.
