- (a) to (c) The Ministry of Urban Development have informed that there is no specific scheme for `Re-use of domestic Waste Water`. However, under the on-going Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), two projects for reuse of recycled water have been approved by the Ministry of Urban Development as detailed below:
- S.No. City Project Name Approved Cost Purpose of reuse (Rs.inlakhs)
- 1 Chandigarh Conservation of drinking 3672.60 Horticulture water by harvesting of the tertiary treated sewage for irrigation of green spaces in Chandigarh
- 2 Nagpur Recycle and Reuse of 13011.00 Power Generation Waste Water (for Thermal Power Station of MahaGenco)
