SCHEME FOR REUSE OF DOMESTIC WASTE WATER

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to formulate a scheme for Reuse of Domestic waste water in view of constantly declining ground water;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the funds allocated for the purpose;and
- (c) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

(a) to (c) The Ministry of Urban Development have informed that there is no specific scheme for 'Re-use of domestic Waste Water'. However, under the on-going Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), two projects for reuse of recycled water have been approved by the Ministry of Urban Development as detailed below:
