CENTRAL HEALTH SCHEMES IN KARNATAKA

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of implementation of the Central Health Scheme in Karnataka during the last three years, year-wise and location-wise;
- (b) the details of new CGHS dispensaries proposed to be opened in the State, location-wise; and
- (c) the details of expenditure incurred by the Union Government on various Central Health Schemes during the last three years, year-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE(SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

- (a): Bangalore is the only city in Karnataka covered by the Central Government Health Scheme. The Scheme has been implemented in Karnataka on 16.12.1976 and has not been expanded.
- (b): There is no proposal to open any new CGHS dispensary in the State of Karnataka.
- (c): The year-wise expenditure for last three years on CGHS is as follows:-
