STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.498 DUE FOR REPLY ON 28.4.2008 REGARDING FUNDS FOR RIVER BASIN PROJECTS.

- (a) State Governments are implementing major, medium and minor irrigation river valley projects in their States. The Union Government is providing funds to the State Governments under Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) for expeditious completion of selected ongoing major/medium projects and surface water minor irrigation schemes.
- (b) The State-wise and project wise details of central assistance released under AIBP during last three years are given in Annex-I.
- (c) & (d) State Governments are also implementing water resources projects with the assistance of the World Bank, Asian Development Bank, JBIC-Japan and Germany. The list of the externally funded projects is enclosed at Annex-II.
