(a),(b),(c)& (d): Under the scheme of Scholarship and Junior Fellowship, the scholarships and fellowships are awarded to young artists in the field of Indian Classical Dance, Indian Classical Music, Theatre, Visual Art and Folk/Traditional forms of Arts etc.

The Centre for Cultural Resource and Training, an autonomous organisation under this Ministry has been revitalizing the education system by creating understanding and awareness among students about the plurality of the regional cultures of India and integrating this with education. The main thrust of the Centre is to make youth aware of the importance of culture in all developmental programmes.

(e),(f) & (g): Under the Scheme of Financial Assistance for Setting up of Multi-Purpose Cultural Complexes to State Governments, West Bengal Government has been given an initial instalment of Rs.35.00 lakhs for setting up of Multi-Purpose Cultural Complex.
