(a) whether the Government has reviewed the implementation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes to keep a check on deadly diseases like Malaria, Tuberculosis, Blindness and AIDS in the various States;

(b) if so, the outcome of this review, State-wise; and

(c) the remedial measures taken/ proposed to be taken thereon?

(a) to (c): Health is a State subject. The Government of India through various national disease control programmes and schemes supplement the efforts of the State Governments to control and keep a check on deadly diseases like Malaria, Tuberculosis, Blindness and AIDS in the country. The review and remedial measures in respect of these disease control programmes are taken from time to time. A statement in this regard is annexed.
