## Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to extend free ATM Facility across the bank affiliation to Urban Co-operative Bank customers in the country as reported in the Times of India dated March 13, 2008; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

## **Answer**

The Minister of State in trie Ministry of Finance (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL)

- (a) & (b): Reserve Bank has issued instruction;; regarding customer charges for use of ATMs for cash withdrawal and balance enquiry to all Primary fJrban) co-operative banks on March 12, 2008. As per the guidelines,
- (i) For use of a banks own ATMs for any purpose, the services will be free with immediate effect
- (ii) For use of other banks` ATMs for balance enquiries, the services will be free with immediate effect
- (iii) For use of other bank ATMs I'or cash withdrawals, the instructions are as indicated below: -
- 1. No bank shall increase the charges prevailing as on December 23, 200" (i.e. the date of release of Approach Paper on RBI website)
- 2. Banks which, are charging more than Rs. 20/- per transaction shall reduce the charges to a maximum of Rs. 20/- per transaction by March 31, 2008
- 3. Free with effect from April 1, 2009.
