(d) to (e): Under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006, notified for operation with effect from 31.12.2007 certain forest rights vests in forest dwelling Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers who primarily reside in and who depend on the forests or forest lands for their bona fide livelihood needs.
