- (a) the number of application forms sold under the Housing Scheme 2008 and the total number out of them received by the Delhi Development Authority (DDA);
- (b) whether the DDA proposes to put all the particulars of the registrants in its website for public information; and
- (c) if so, the time by which such information would be made available?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a): The Delhi Development Authority has informed that under the Housing Scheme 2008, a total of 8,99,445 application forms were sold through Banks and at DDA counter. Apart from this, 4,02,077 application forms were downloaded through DDA website. Out of these, a total of 5,66,084 application forms have been received by DDA through various Banks.

(b)&(c): DDA has informed that the application form number of the applicants will be put on DDA website by the end of November, 2008.
