(a)to(d): For integrated development of slums through projects for providing shelter, basic services and other civic amenities with a view to provide utilities to the urban poor in select 63 cities a Sub-mission on Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) has been launched on 03.12.2005. In the remaining cities/towns an Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) has also been launched on 03.12.2005. IHSDP has subsumed Valmiki Ambedkar Awas Yojana (VAMBAY) and National Slum Development Programme (NSDP). The targeted beneficiaries are slum dwellers/urban poor/EWS/LIG categories.
