- (a) whether the Government has proposed some fresh guidelines to allow 49 per cent Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the Defence Sector as against the existing 26 per cent;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the countries with which negotiations have been made and the steps taken to make the entire procedure transparent?

Answer

- (a) & (b): As per extant policy Indian private sector participation is allowed up to 100% in defence industry sector with FDI up to 26%, both subject to licensing. At present Government has no proposal to increase the present level of FDI from 26% to 49% in the sector.
