(a), (b) & (c): With a view to updating the existing Programme & Advertisement Codes and to bring them at par with the contemporary community standards, Government had constituted a Committee in October, 2005 under the chairmanship of the Secretary,l&B,inter-alia, comprising of the representatives of relevant Ministries,broadcasting/film/advertising organizations,civil society groups,consumer forum. Secretary,l&B has submitted the report of the Committee to the Government in March, 2008 which includes a chapter on news programmes and the same is posted on the website of this Ministry www.mib.nic.in for wider public consultation and therefore no definite time frame can be given.
