Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to issue new guidelines for selection of athletes and coaches and for more efficient management of sports coaching camps as reported in the The Hindu dated 21st September, 2008.
- (b) if so, details thereof outlining the modifications made in the existing guidelines; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government for implementation of these guidelines?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS(DR. M.S. GILL)

(a)to(c): Government on 18th September,2008 issued comprehensive guidelines for more efficient management of Coaching Camps, selection of coaches, selection of Athletes, etc. At present no further fresh guidelines are proposed to be issued.

All implementing agencies are required to follow these guidelines. Government undertakes detailed scrutiny of proposals received from National Sports Federations seeking financial assistance for competition/training in India & abroad. The proposals are cleared only after ensuring that the guidelines have been adhered to while selecting the team.
