(a) the existing import duty on various items of food products;

(b) whether the Government proposes to increase the import duty to protect the domestic food products; and

(c) if so, the rate of import duty proposed to be levied?

(a) The current basic customs duty rates applicable to certain essential food products are placed at Annexure.

(b)&(c) At present, there is no such proposal under consideration. However, import duties are reviewed periodically on the basis of a number of factors including the international and domestic prices of a commodity, domestic availability, the interests of the consumers, the impact on domestic producers, the administrative feasibility of collection and revenue consideration.
