- (b) to (d) Details of violations of the provision of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules (MCDR) Rules pointed out, rectified, cases filed etc. for the 2008-2009 (up to November, 2008) reported by IBM is given in Annexure-II.
- (e) & (f) Mining operations are subject to environment and forest clearances, which require compliance of the statutory provisions in respect of the environment and pollution control.
