- (a) whether the said Commissions have since been constituted;
- (b) whether the Government also propose to set up a National Commission to examine the reservation in educational institutions for socially and economically backward sections amongst religious and linguistic minorities in the country;
- (c) if so, the complete details of each Commission separately including their composition terms of reference, salient features and objectives; and
- (d) the time by which the said Commissions are likely to submit their reports?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SMT. SUBBULAKSHMI JAGADEESAN) (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Terms of Reference of the National Commission for welfare of socially and economically backward sections among religious and linguistic Minorities
- (NCRLM) inter-alia includes the issue of reservation in educational institutions. Therefore, there is no proposal for a separate Commission.
- (c) & (d) The details in respect of NCRLM have been notified vide Resolution No. 1- 11/2004-MC (D) dated 29.10.2004. The details in respect of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions have been notified vide No. F. 11-2/2004-MC(P) dated 16.11.2004.
