(a) to (c) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. The Gadhuli – Santalpur road is not a National Highway. The proposal of State Government of Rs 127.16 crore for Gadhuli – Santalpur road was returned to State Government for modification. The revised proposal amounting to Rs 165.83 crore has since been received and is under consideration with the Government.
