(a) & (b): The guidelines and parameters to identify the backward districts in the country is issued by the Planning Commission. Accordingly, due weightage to backwardness is given while the central allocation is distributed amongst States and districts in allocation-based programmes of the Ministry of Rural Development. The Ministry of Pajnchayati Raj is implementing a scheme namely, Backward Regions Grant Fund (BRGF) since 2006-07 aiming at to address regional imbalances in development. At present there is no proposal for reviewing the BRGF programme guidelines.
